PLAINTIFF'S EX-PARTE APPLICATION FOR COURT TO REOPEN CASE

Plaintiff Barbara Cegavske, in her official capacity as Nevada's Secretary of State, through counsel, Aaron D. Ford, Attorney General, and Brandee Mooneyhan, Deputy Attorney General, respectfully applies for the Court to reopen this case so that it may address the merits of Plaintiff's motion filed May 4, 2020.

On May 4, 2020, Plaintiff filed an "Ex-Parte Motion to (1) Extend Time to Serve Process; and (2) Allow Service of Process by Publication," based on Defendant Christian Gronau's apparent evasion of service. The next activity in the case was on February 9, 2021, when the Court entered a "Civil Order to Statistically Close Case," noting that the case was involuntarily dismissed pursuant to EDCR 1.90. It appears the case was closed

without addressing the pending motion because no proposed order regarding the motion was submitted to the Court. Counsel was unaware that a proposed order should be submitted before the Court ruled on the motion and sincerely apologizes for the oversight. Because it appears Defendants continue to engage in the conduct set forth in the complaint, namely, conducting business without a state business license, Plaintiff would like to pursue this matter, and urges that the pending motion should be resolved on its merits, rather than the case being closed based on a procedural error. Counsel has now prepared a proposed order regarding the May 4, 2020, motion and it will be submitted promptly if this Court reopens this matter.
